THE NECESSITY OF LIGHT IN THE GOSPEL

"For with You is the fountain of life: In Your light we see light." (Psalm 36:9) This Psalm was written by David. David knew something about light. He discovered that with God there is no hiding. He found this out in a very unfortunate way, through his affair with Bathsheba and the murder of her husband, Uriah. David knew he had sinned because he tried to cover it up by arranging for Uriah's death, but it took Nathan, the prophet, to cause him to repent. I believe that because God revealed to Nathan David's sin, the fear of God pierced David's heart like a fiery shaft. God was merciful and forgave David, yet there were many repercussions that his sins put into motion. What David also learned was "Even the darkness is not dark to You, and the night is as bright as the day. Darkness and light are alike to You." (Psalm 139:12) He found out

that what he kept secret, God exposed to all Israel. He reaped what he sowed, and the crop, of any kind of seed, whether wheat or tares, is going to yield greater than the planting. One seed will duplicate multitudes more of its kind, be it good or bad.

This Old Testament history paints a picture of what God wants to happen as a result of our preaching the light of the Gospel of the glory of Christ. Jesus' Great Commission to preach the Gospel is also accompanied with power. He began the commissioning by saying "All authority is given to me in heaven and on earth. Go therefore and make disciples - - - ." Then He said He would be with them even to the end of the age. Well, here we are! **That's us.** The same power that Nathan had that brought conviction to David, the King of Israel, is what we have and even more power because the glory of the New Covenant is far greater than the glory of the Old Covenant. (2 Corinthians 3:9) That's why Paul said, "For I am not ashamed of the gospel, for it is the power of God for salvation to everyone who believes, to the Jew first and also to the Greek." Jesus said, "I am the Light of the world; he who follows Me will not walk in the darkness, but will have the Light of life." (John 8:12) These two words go together because eternal life can only come after spiritual light is shed upon hearts.(John 1:4)
