Waiting Upon the Lord

“ May those who fear Thee, see me and be glad, because I wait for Thy word.” (Psalm 119:24)

David heard form God because he waited for His word to come. What every person needs, more than anything else, is to hear God speak, not once or twice but throughout one’s whole life. (Matthew 4:4).

Watchmen Nee (from his Bio) said, “Faith comes by revelation, without the latter, there can be no faith.” David knew this saying, “For You, O LORD of hosts, the God of Israel, have made a revelation to Your servant, saying, ‘I will build you a house’; THEREFORE YOUR SERVANT HAS FOUND COURAGE TO PRAY this prayer to You.” (2 Samuel 7:27). When he received a revelation from God, he was given courage to pray for the fulfillment of it. This revelation came through Nathan, the prophet in verses 4-17 of the same chapter. We were born again because we received a revelation from God that we are guilty as

And how will they hear without a preacher? How will they preach unless they are sent? Just as it is written, “HOW BEAUTIFUL ARE THE FEET OF THOSE WHO BRING GOOD NEWS OF GOOD THINGS”

However, they did not all heed the good news; for Isaiah says, “LORD, WHO HAS BELIEVED OUR REPORT?” So faith comes from hearing, and hearing by the word of Christ. (Romans 10:14 -17). It is true that some will not believe, actually most will not, but the report has to be heard in order for some to believe, ie. have faith which comes first by hearing. As Christians, we all need to wait on God. The Psalms, Isaiah and other books have many references to that. We need the refreshing that comes from the Presence of the Lord and waiting on the Lord leads us to that refreshing.

I do not consider myself as having attained it yet, but I hope, pray, and strive for the day when the word of the Lord that I speak to the lost actually manifests as the voice of the Lord and that they recognize that the voice they hear is not mine but is that of the Lion of the tribe of Judah and that they will know that “A lion has roared! Who will not fear? The Lord GOD has spoken! Who can but prophesy?” (Amos 3:8) And then they will know their depravity before a Holy God, and that knowledge leads them to repentance.

While preaching at Ohio State, I noticed two male and two female students listening for a long while. Later as I was sitting in a bench waiting for classes to change, they approached me and had questions about my ‘message’ What this amounted to was, “ Do I think people go hell for being gay? I told them people go to hell because they do not repent of their sins. Being gay was just one of many. That didn’t satisfy them, of course. The two females were lesbians and one had several occult-like tattoos. They wanted me to tell them it was okay to be gay which I will never do. The conversation went from discussion to resentment until they walked away and made their negative comments. The last thing I told them, loud enough for everyone to hear, was one thing that is certain, is that “...you would not be here if it were not for a man and a woman.”

On another day, I was challenged by a man in his 50’s who was visiting with friends and not a Christian. He couldn’t imagine why I would be preaching to people in public. He actually did not understand. I explained to him the examples in the Bible and the commands to go into all the world to preach the gospel. He quickly mellowed out, we shook hands and he left. But in the process, I was able to share some of the Gospel with him.
